The National Student Board Member Association (NSBMA)

NSBMA is the only national organization that specifically focuses on empowering and elevating students on school boards across the United States. NSBMA is the first association built by and for student board members (SBMs). With over 1,000 students serving on school boards nationally, our organization and the student board members we serve represent a total of 20 million students. Our work fosters youth civic engagement and we aim to ensure that students have representation in the education field.

Student Trustee Action Readiness Training (START+)

The START+ virtual conference is dedicated to training the next generation of student school board members across America. Building on last year's START success, and in addition to the three-day online conference, START+ 2024 features three online webinars throughout the school year, as well as ongoing, tailored support for participants.

Taking place from August 16 to 18, START+ will bring together **around 50 student board members from across the United States**, who represent the interests of their peers on local, state and public charter school boards. We estimate that approximately 40% of students in the US are currently represented through student board members, and we are actively working with students and school districts to expand student board member positions across the country.





START+ focuses on school board governance processes and mechanisms, providing hands-on training through policy development and a mock board meeting to prepare student board members for a term of service. The online training presents a unique opportunity for educational companies and foundations to engage with future educational leaders and decision-makers. Student Board Members

The student board member role is the **only governmental role for individuals under 18 years old**. Student board members bridge the communication gap between students and administrators, fostering **meaningful student representation**, increasing effectiveness in addressing student issues, and ensuring that decisions reflect the actual needs and experiences of the student body.

As the voice of students on their school board, student board members are able to **widely gather information** and **share it with their student body**. Each student board member **represents their entire district**, which can range from **1,000 to 500,000 students**. Through newsletters, social media, and other means of reaching their peers, student board members **amplify and disseminate** crucial information through a network that does not exist elsewhere by students in the school community.
